ORDER

The allegation in this case is that the accused was found to be in possession of eight bottles of liquor of 180 ml each. It is also alleged that he was indulging in breaking them open and distributing the same as 90 ml bottles.



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2. Considering the fact that the entire quantity is still less than the personal consumable limit and the fact that from the year 2018, summons itself has not been served, any further service of summons and continuation of the proceedings would impinge upon the right to speedy trial of the accused in the context of the present allegations.

3. Hence, the proceedings in S.T.C.No. 901151 of 2018 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate II, Ariyalur Taluk, Ariyalur shall stand quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stands allowed.
