ORDER

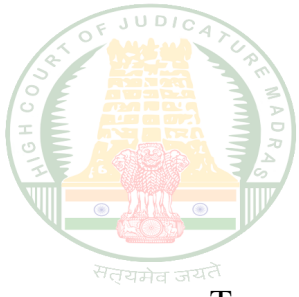
(Order of this Court was made by M.S.RAMESH.J.)
