ORDER

In view of the nature of allegations in this case, I am of the view that this is a fit case for exercise of power under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 as per the dictum of the Honourable Supreme Court of India in *Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and Anr. reported in (2012) 10 SCC 303*.

4. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.244 of 2020 shall stands quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stands disposed of.
