This Writ Petition is filed to call for the records of 4th respondent



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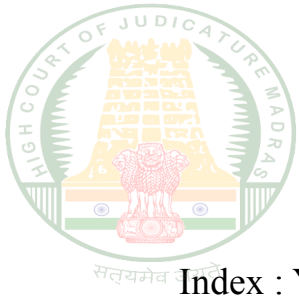
contained in its letter dated 12.11.2022 in R.No.3418534/E7/A1/2022 and the
