ORDER

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This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking to consider petitioner's representation dated 04.08.2025 and to direct the 3rd respondent to issue NOC in respect of the subject property plot No.67 situated in S.No.7/3, Saravanampatti Village, Coimbatore Taluk of Deiveega Nagar.

2.Mr.C.Jayaprakash, learned Government Advocate, takes notice on behalf of the respondents 1 to 5. By consent of the parties, the main writ petition is taken up for disposal at the admission stage itself.

3.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents.

4.The grievance of the petitioner before this Court is that the representation of the petitioner dated 04.08.2025 has not been considered by the 3rd respondent so far.

This Court, at this stage, is not expressing any view on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner, as it is for the 3rd respondent to consider and decide the same on merits and in accordance with law. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of, only by directing the 3rd respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 04.08.2025 and pass orders on the same on merits and in accordance with law. Such exercise shall be done by the 3rd respondent within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
