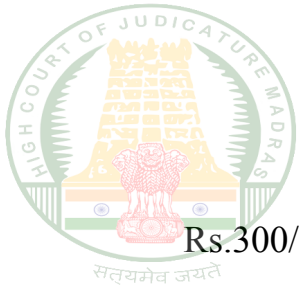

ORDER

The allegation in this case is that the accused drove the vehicle and caused injuries to the defacto complainant. The defacto complainant is present and states that he has no objection to closing the case. The accused pleaded guilty.

2. Considering the nature of the offence and the fact that the complainant has forgiven the accused, this Court imposes a fine of Rs.200/- for the offence under Section 279 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), 1860 and



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Rs.300/- for the offence under Section 337 of IPC, totalling Rs.500/-. The fine

shall be paid on the next date of hearing before the Trial Court.

3. Accordingly, the S.T.C.No.100688 of 2018 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate Court No. I, Jayamkondam Taluk, Ariyalur shall stands disposed of and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stands allowed.
