ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. The case is registered for alleged offence under Sections 279, 337 & 304 (A) of Indian Penal Code. The incident occurred on 11.03.2017. It is submitted that the defacto complainant has received the compensation.



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3. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the summons could not be served, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the proceedings in C.C.No.200160 of 2018 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate Court No.II, Jayamkondam Taluk, Ariyalur is quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
