ORDER

This Suo Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Suo Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The case was registered in Cr.No.14 of 2011 dated 07.07.2011 for the alleged offence under Section 498 (A), 494 r/w 109 I.P.C. and Section 4 of TNPWH Act and Section 4 and 6 of Dowry Prohibition Act. It is reported the prime accused husband being A1 was dead. The mother case in C.C.No.114 of

2020 proceeded further and resulted in an acquittal. The grounds for acquittal also apply to the present accused. The matter has been pending for the execution of warrant against A2 since 2012.

3.Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the background of the accused, the reason for absence from her usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon her right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4.Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.63 of 2021 of Additional Mahila Court (in the cadre of Judicial Magistrate), Villupuram Taluk, Villupuram, stands quashed. This Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
