ORDER

This Suo Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Suo Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case, **Cr.No.1223 of 2021** is registered for alleged offences under **Section 379, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860**. The accused had involved in theft of two wheeler of the defacto complainant. It is reported that the stolen bike was recovered and handed over to the defacto complainant and he does not want to press the case and is willing to compound the matter.

3. It is also reported that A3 alone is attending the case, whereas warrant is pending for A1 and A2. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the case in ***C.C.No.187 of 2022 of Judicial Magistrate Court No.II, Tiruppur, Tiruppur Taluk, Tiruppur*** is quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
