Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a Writ of Declaration, declaring the stipulation of "pre-import condition" introduced through paragraph 1 of Notification No.33/2015-2020, dated 13.10.2017 in paragraph No.4.14 of the Foreign Trade Police (2015-20) issued by the 2nd respondent and which existed during the period 13.10.2017 to 10.01.2019, as ultra vires being violative of Article 14 of the Constitution of India.

Prayer in W.P.No.31741 of 2022:

Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a Writ of Declaration, declaring the stipulation of "pre-import condition" introduced through Notification No.79/2017-customs, dated 13.10.2017 in clause (xii) of Notification No.18/2015-cus. issued by the 4th respondent and which existed during the period 13.10.2017 to 10.01.2019, as ultra vires being violative of Article 14 of the Constitution of India.

Prayer in W.P.No.31742 of 2022:

Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a Writ of Certiorari, calling for records relating to show cause notice F No.CUS/APR/SCN/185/2022 GR-2, dated 12.10.2022 issued by the 3rd respondent and quash the saem as arbitrary and illegal
