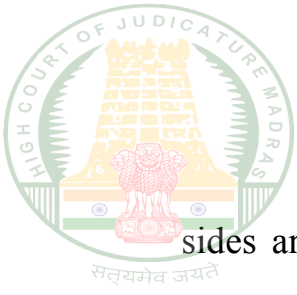

ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The case, Cr.No.13 of 2006 was registered for the alleged offence under Section 498 (A) and 406 I.P.C. and Section 4 of TNPWH Act. The occurrence is of the year 2006. The defacto-complainant as well as the accused are not found in the respective address. They remain untraceable inspite of the best efforts by the Police. After eighteen years, even if both



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sides are traced out, no meaningful trial is possible and no useful purpose would be served.

3. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.1 of 2020 of Additional Mahila Court, Egmore Taluk, Chennai, stands quashed. This Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
