This petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 132 days in filing the above appeal.

2. Mr.J.Chandran, learned counsel takes notice on behalf of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent remained exparte before the trial court.

4. In view of the above, notice to the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent is dispensed with.

5. Heard learned counsel on either side.

6. Being satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, this Court is inclined to order this petition.

7. Accordingly this petition is allowed. Registry is directed to number the appeal, if it is otherwise in order and post the matter for admission.
