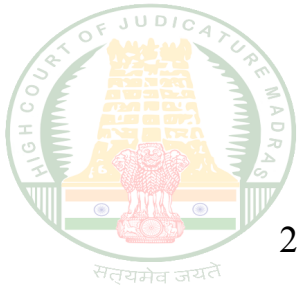

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2. This Case in Cr.No.410 of 2017 is registered for alleged offences

under Sections 147, 341, 294(b), 323, 506(2) of Indian Penal Code. The parties have moved on and have no objection to the case being disposed of on compromise. Due to the unique manner in which this designated bench conducts hybrid hearings, the filing of written affidavits or terms of compromise is dispensed with. Considering the factual matrix, the context in which the conflict arose, the background of the parties, and their present position, this is an appropriate case for the exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as per ***Gian Singh -vs- State of Punjab & another, (2012 10 SCC 303)***.

3. Accordingly, the proceedings in CC.267/2019 of Judicial Magistrate Court No.II , Kallakurichi Taluk, Kallakurichi is quashed and this Suo Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
