ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case is registered for alleged offences under Sections 188, 270, 271 and 505(i)(b) of the Indian Penal Code. The incident occurred on 26.03.2020. The allegation in this case is that the accused gave some wrong information to the Police Control number in order to trace out his wife in violation of the lock down regulations. Considering the factual matrix, the context of the case, the background of the accused, the reason for his absence



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at his place of residence, and the submission made that, despite best efforts, the summons could not be served from the year 2020, it is clear that even if the accused faces trial, no useful purpose would be served.

3. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.129 of 2021 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.3, Erode Taluk, Erode, stands quashed. This Suo Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
