Order

This Sua Motu case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by this Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.)No.618 of 2025.

2. This case is registered for alleged offences under Section 379 of IPC, 1860. The incident occurred on 18.03.2017. The stolen mobile phone has been



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recovered and handed over to the de facto complainant.

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3. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, and the case is pending for the past eight years, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.933 of 2017 on the file of VII Metropolitan Magistrate Court, George Town Taluk, Chennai, stands quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer case is disposed of.
