**ORDER**

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case is registered for alleged offences under Sections 294(b), 332 and 506(ii) of the Indian Penal Code. The incident occurred on 03.07.2015. The allegation in this case is that when the de facto complainant Police personnel was on duty and when he questioned the accused for riding his motor cycle in a rash and negligent manner, the accused not only abused



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the Police personnel, but, also slapped him on his cheek. It is stated that there is no previous or subsequent case against the accused. The case is pending from the year 2015 at the stage of summons and till date, no progress is made. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the summons could not be served, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

3. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.184 of 2019 of District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court, Uthukuli, stands quashed. This Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
