ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(CrI.) No.618 of 2025.

2. The allegation in this case is that on 03.08.2018 there was a wordy quarrel between the accused and the defacto complainant, which resulted in minor injuries on the defacto complainant. Therefore, a case in Cr.No.273 of 2018 was registered for an offence under Section 294 (b) and 324 of IPC. The case is pending at the stage of summons. The defacto complainant has passed away. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the summons could not be served, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, no meaningful trial is likely to be taken place and no useful purpose would be served.
