ORDER

This petition is filed by the petitioner, who is one of the advertisers, complaining that many hoardings and advertisements are being erected by 4th and 5th respondents without obtaining any permission. Even though several complaints have been made, the Corporation is not taking any action.



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2. We find that representations have been made on various dates in the month of July and August, 2025 only and this petition has now been filed before this Court.

3. Learned counsel for the Corporation, on advance copy, would submit that the complaints made would be examined in accordance with law.

In that view of the matter, we are not inclined to keep this petition pending. Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, the interim applications stand closed.
