ORDER

This Suo Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Suo Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. The case was registered in Cr.No.558 of 2016 for the alleged offence under Sections 457 and 511 of I.P.C. The allegation in this case is that the accused attempted to steal and at that time caught redhanded. The case is pending from the year 2016 at the stage of execution of warrant on the accused. There is no previous case or subsequent case as against the accused.

The defacto complainant also does not wants to pursue the matter.

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3. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the proceedings in C.C.No.600011 of 2017 of Judicial Magistrate Court No.I, Perambalur Taluk, Perambalur, is quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
