ORDER

This Suo Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Suo Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The allegation in this case is that on 15.05.2015, the accused protested against the Government without due permission. A case was registered in Cr.No.260 of 2015 for the alleged offence under Sections 143, 188 and 353 of I.P.C. The final report was filed and the accused have been facing trial since then. Thus, it can be seen that the allegations concern exercising the democratic right to protest. Given the context and nature of allegations, continuing the trial impinges on the right to a speedy trial of the accused. No useful purpose will be served by continuing the case.
