ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case and C.C.No.357 of 2016 are connected, as that case was split up from the present one. The allegation in this case is that the accused had stolen iron rod from SIPCOT. The stolen property has been recovered and is now kept in the custody of the Court. The defacto complainant has not appeared before the Court concerned to take the property back. If the defacto complainant approaches the Court within a reasonable time, the property shall be returned. Otherwise, the same may be disposed of in the manner known to law.

3. As far as A1 is concerned, summons could not be served and warrant is pending. A2 is also shown as warrant pending. It is further reported that there is no previous or subsequent case as against the petitioner.

4. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

5. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.100220 of 2012 on the file of Judicial Magistrate Court, Sriperumbudur Taluk, Kancheepuram shall stand quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stand disposed of.
