PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to disburse the belated payment of interest amount of Provident Fund, Gratuity & Commutation amounts and other unsettled benefits of Earned Leave salary surrender for the year 2009-2011 & 2016 - 2019 and 10 days salary amounts with effect from 01.06.2018 within the stipulated time.

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ORDER

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2.The petitioner has filed this writ petition to issue a Writ of Mandamus, seeking for a direction, directing the respondents to disburse the belated payment of interest amount of Provident Fund, Gratuity & Commutation amounts and other unsettled benefits of Earned Leave salary surrender for the year 2009-2011 & 2016 - 2019 and 10 days salary amounts with effect from 01.06.2018 within the stipulated time.

3.The case of the petitioner is that the petitioner retired from the Respondent/Corporation on 30.06.2023 as a Senior Superintendent at P.F. & Pension Wing. The grievance of the petitioner is that the terminal benefits was settled belatedly, due to which he is entitled for interest for the belated payment. Therefore, the petitioner gave a representation to the respondents on 08.07.2025. Since no action has been taken by the respondents till now, the petitioner is before this Court.



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4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would be suffice if this Court issues a direction to the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders.

5. Learned standing counsel appearing for the respondents submitted that the representation of the petitioner will be considered and they will make arrangements to pay the eligible amount with interest at 6% per annum as per the earlier orders of this Court.

6. In the light of the above, this Court directs the Respondent / Corporation to pay the eligible amount due and payable to the petitioner along with interest at the rate of 6% per annum for the delay period in settling the said amount. This payment shall be made within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. It is made clear that if the amount is not paid within the time frame fixed by this Court, the same shall be paid with interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the date on which the amount became due and till the date of actual payment.
