ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. In this matter, both the defacto complainant and the accused are migrant labourers. They have since returned to their native places. In spite of best efforts, whereabouts of both the accused as well as the defacto complainant remain untraceable. On behalf of the prosecution, steps have been taken to withdraw this case and withdrawal proceedings have already been

filed before the trial Court.

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3. Considering the nature of allegations in this case and despite genuine efforts, the migrant labourers could not be traced. No meaningful trial is possible and no purpose will be served by keeping this matter pending. Even though withdrawal proceedings have been filed, since this Dedicated Bench has taken up the issue, the case need not remain pending on the file of the learned Magistrate any further.

4. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.700713 of 2017 on the file of Judicial Magistrate Court No.I, Tiruppur, Tiruppur Taluk, Tiruppur shall stand quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stand disposed of.
