ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.This case is registered in Cr.No.1420 of 2020 for the alleged offences under Sections 341, 294(b) & 353 of the I.P.C. The allegation in this case is that the accused is said to have stopped the car of the defacto-complainant Bank Manager, protesting that his jewels are not handed over to him even after redemption and he also abused the defacto-complainant for the said allegation. The case is pending for execution of NBW since 2020.

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3.Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4.Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.210 of 2021 of Judicial Magistrate Court No.1, Mannargudi Taluk, Tiruvarur, stands quashed. This Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
