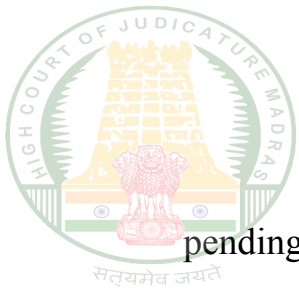

ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. The case was registered in Cr.No.20 of 2006 for the alleged offence under Sections 341, 323 and 506(i) of the I.P.C. The mother case in C.C.No.205 of 2006 proceeded further and resulted in an acquittal. The grounds for acquittal also apply to the present accused. The matter has been

pending for the execution of warrant.

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3. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the background of the accused, the reason for his absence at his place of residence, and the submission made that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon her right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.11 of 2019 of District Munsif Court cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Veppanthattai Taluk, Perambalur, stands quashed. This Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
