2. The case was registered in Cr.No.426 of 2012 dated 22.02.2012 for the alleged offence under Section 379 of Indian Penal Code, 1860. It is stated that the accused were platform dwellers and absolutely not traceable, however it considering the fact that the property is not recovered and the complainant is having objection, for the present, this case may be treated as closed. However, in future if any clue is obtained as against the accused, the case can be reopened and reconstructed. Therefore, this Court finds it to be a fit case to invoke its extraordinary power under Article 226 of the Constitution of India
