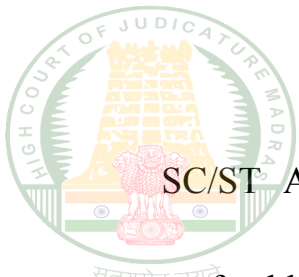

preferably on the same day of their surrender in connection with Crime No.595

of 2025 on the file of the second respondent and pass appropriate orders in

accordance with law, after affording due opportunity to the victims under

Section 15-A of the SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989. The petitioner shall surrender

before the concerned Jurisdictional Court, within a period of fifteen days from

the date of the receipt of a copy of this Order.
