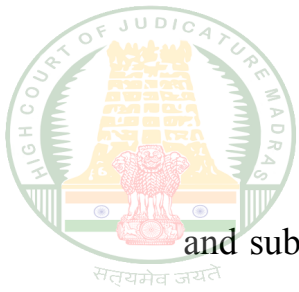

ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case is registered for alleged offence under Section 392 of Indian Penal Code. The incident occurred on 30.10.2021. The allegation in this case is that the accused has stolen two wheeler bearing Registration No.TN-19-T-6388 from the defacto complainant. The defacto complainant is present



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and submits that the two wheeler has been handed over. There is no previous case or subsequent case as against the accused. The case is pending at the stage of issue of fresh summon to the accused. The defacto complainant also does not wants to pursue the matter. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the summon could not be served, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

3. Accordingly, the proceedings in C.C.No.7 of 2023 of District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Cheyyur Taluk, Chengalpattu, is quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
