6.Considering the submission made by both the parties and in view of the limited prayer sought for in this Writ Petition, without going into the merits of the case, this Court directs the 3rd respondent to consider the application of the petitioners dated 06.04.2025 and dispose of the same on merits and in



accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a
copy of this order.
