This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. **This Case in Crime No.127 of 2007 is registered for alleged offences under Sections 294, 323, 506(ii) r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code and 177 of MV Act.** The parties have moved on and have no objection to the case being disposed of on compromise. Due to the unique manner in which this

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dedicated bench conducts hybrid hearings, the filing of written affidavits or terms of compromise is dispensed with. Considering the factual matrix, the context in which the conflict arose, the background of the parties, and their present position, this is an appropriate case for the exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as per ***Gian Singh -vs- State of Punjab & another, (2012 10 SCC 303).***

3. Accordingly, the proceedings in **C.C.No.1600211 of 2016 on the file of Judicial Magistrate No.VII, Puducherry Taluk, Puducherry** is quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
