This petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 285 days in filing the above appeal.

2. Mr.Ashok Kumar, learned counsel takes notice on behalf of the 1st respondent, Mr.Guruprasad, learned counsel takes notice on behalf of the respondents 4 to 6.

3. Though notice was served and the names of the 2nd & 3rd respondents were printed in cause list, none appeared on their behalf.

4. Heard learned counsel on either side.

5. Being satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, this Court is inclined to order this petition.

6. Accordingly this petition is allowed. Registry is directed to number the appeal, if it is otherwise in order and post the matter for admission.

7. It is underscored that in the eventuality of the appellants succeeding in the appeal to be taken on record, they would not be entitled to any interest for 285 days.
