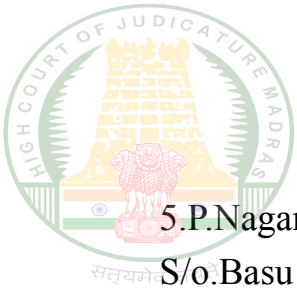

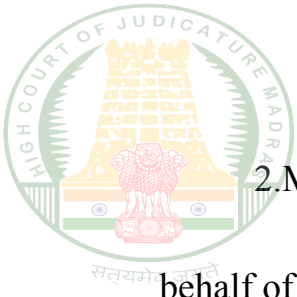

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking to direct the respondents 1 to 4 to issue patta by considering the representation of the petitioner dated 24.06.2025.

3.The grievance of the petitioner before this Court is that the representation of the petitioner dated 24.06.2025 has not been considered by the respondents 1 to 4 so far.
