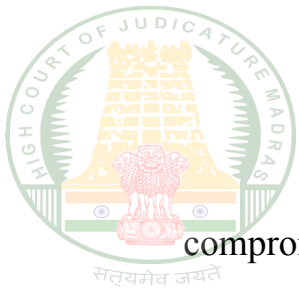

ORDER

This Suo Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Suo Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case, Cr.No.2501 of 2020 is registered for alleged offences under Section 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(2) of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002. The parties have moved on and have no objection to the case being disposed of on



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compromise. Due to the unique manner in which this designated bench

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conducts hybrid hearings, the filing of written affidavits or terms of compromise is dispensed with. Considering the factual matrix, the context in which the conflict arose, the background of the parties, and their present position, this is an appropriate case for the exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as per ***Gian Singh -Vs State of Punjab & another, (2012 10 SCC 303).***

3. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.129 of 2021 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate Court, Dharapuram, Dharapuram Taluk, Tiruppur shall stand quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stand disposed of.
