ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The case in Cr.No.128 of 2016 was registered for the alleged offences under Sections 6 (4) of TN Scheduled Commodities [RDSCS] Order, 1982 r/w 7 (i) (a) (ii) of Essential Commodities Act, 1955. The occurrence is of the year 2016. The allegation in this case is that the accused was found to be in possession of 5000 kgs of PDS rice. There are no previous or subsequent previous cases against the accused. The matter has been pending since 2016.

3.Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the summons could not be served, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.450 of 2019 of Judicial Magistrate No.I, Krishnagiri Taluk, Krishnagiri, stands quashed. This Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
