ORDER

This petition has been filed to enlarge the petitioner on bail in connection with Cr.No.208 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner allegedly committed robbery and exorted Rs.500 from the defacto complainant. Hence, the FIR registered under section 126 (2), 296(b), 115(2), 125, 309(4), 311, 351(3) of BNSS.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner no way connected with this case and has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays to allow this petition.

3. The learned Government Advocate criminal side raised objection to grant bail to the petitioner.



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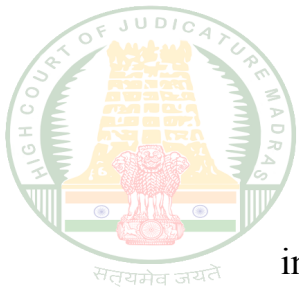
4. Considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner and also the fact that investigation is almost completed. Hence, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with conditions.

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing separate bonds for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, **in which one surety must be a blood surety** for a like sum to the satisfaction of the *Judicial Magistrate No.II, Thiruvallur*, and on further conditions that::

(a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for the period of three months.

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;



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(d) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]*; and;

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.

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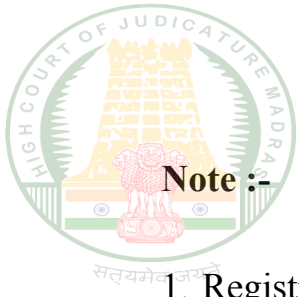
