ORDER

This Sua Motu case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.)No.618 of 2025.

2. This case, Cr.No.1299 of 2016 is registered for alleged offence(s) under Sections 341, 324, 294(b), 506(ii) of IPC, 1860 and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002. The defacto complainant is present and have no objection to the case being disposed of on compromise. Due to the unique manner in which this designated bench conducts hybrid hearings, the filing of written affidavits or terms of compromise is dispensed with. Considering the factual matrix, the context in which the conflict arose, the background of the parties, and their present position, this is an appropriate case for the exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as per ***Gian Singh -Vs-State of Punjab & another, (2012 10 SCC 303)***.
