ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case in crime no.1247 of 2017 is registered for alleged offence under Sections 379 of Indian Penal Code. The incident occurred during the year 2017. The allegation in this case is that the accused has stolen



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cash of Rs.200/- from the defacto complainant. Now it is submitted that the

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money was recovered and handed over to the defacto complainant. The

defacto complainant does not want to pursue the matter any further. It is

reported that there is no previous or subsequent case against the accused.

Now, the matter is pending at the stage of service of fresh summons.

Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, antecedents of the

accused, the reason for absence from his usual place and the submission that,

despite best efforts, the summons could not be served, it is evident that even if

the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a

speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no

useful purpose would be served.

3. Accordingly, the proceedings in CC.807 of 2024 of District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Sholinganallur Taluk, Chengalpattu is quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
