ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The defacto-complainant is present before this Court. The case arises out of matrimonial discard. The accused was tried for the offence under Sections 294 (b), 323 and 506 (2) I.P.C., and Section 4 of TN Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002, in Cr.No.220 of 2022. It is stated that the husband and wife joined together and the complainant does not want to pursue the case any further.

3.Following the dictum of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in ***B.S.Joshi Vs. State of Haryana (2003 4 SCC 675)***, this is a fit case for exercise of the jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. In view of the extraordinary mode in which this designated bench conducts hybrid hearings, the filing of written affidavits/terms of compromise is dispensed with.
