Considering the factual matrix, the context in which the conflict arose, the background of the parties, and their present position, this is an appropriate case for the exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as per ***Gian Singh -Vs State of Punjab & another, (2012 10 SCC 303).***

4. Accordingly, this case in C.C.No.197 of 2019 and connected case in C.C.No.277 of 2019 on the file of the Additional Mahila Court, tiruvannamalai Taluk, Tiruvannamalai, shall stand quashed and this Suo Motu Transfer Case stands disposed of.
