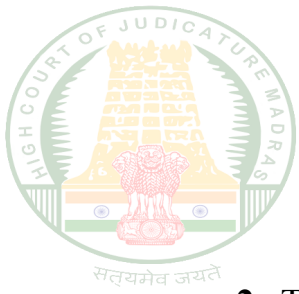

ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 09.08.2025 for the alleged offence under Sections 296(b), 351(2) of BNS, 2023, and Section 4 of TNPHW Act, 2002, in Crime No.244 of 2025, on the file of respondent police, seeks bail.



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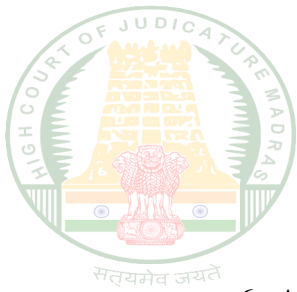
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2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was employed as a driver of the Red Taxi owned by the defacto complainant. On one occasion, the petitioner requested the defacto complainant's mobile phone and she handed it over to him. It is alleged that the petitioner thereafter downloaded her nude photographs and abused her. Hence, the present complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated, as if he abused the defacto complainant. He further submits that the petitioner has been suffering incarceration from 09.08.2025. Hence, he seeks for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent police, opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner and submitted that the investigation has been completed. He further submitted that no photographs were published on social media.

5. Considering the facts, the submissions made by both counsels, and the fact that the investigation has been completed, and also considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.



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6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, **in which one surety must be a blood surety** for a like sum to the satisfaction of the ***Additional Mahila Court, Coimbatore***, and on further conditions that:

(a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police on every alternate days at 5.00 p.m. for a period of three months.

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]***; and;

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.

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(g) the petitioner shall not communicate with the defacto complainant in any manner and shall file an affidavit of undertaking, affirming that he will not post or circulate any photographs of the defacto complainant on social media or any other platform hereinafter.
