Considering the above said submissions made by the learned counsel appearing on both the sides, facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the view that the petitioner can be granted visitation rights on alternate Sundays at 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon at the Shivan Temple, Padi which is nearest to the residence of the respondent. The first date of visitation commences on 07.12.2025.
