**PRAYER**

Writ Petition is filed under Art. 226 of Constitution of India seeking for issuance of a Writ of Certiorari, calling for records relating to the Notification of the 1st respondent made in Advt.No.692-Notification No.11/2024 dated 13.8.2024 to quash the same in so far as Clause 3-Post and Vacancies Sl.No.4 with post code 2119 and that of clause 4.3 Educational, Technical qualification and Experience in Sl.No.4 therein are concerned.

## **ORDER**

This Writ Petition has been filed challenging the impugned Notification issued by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent made in Advt. No.692, Notification No.11/2024 dated 13.08.2024 and to quash the same in so far as Clause – 3 – Post and Vacancies, Sl. No.4 with Post Code:2119 and that of Clause – 4.3 Educational, Technical Qualifications and Experience in Sl.No.4 therein.

2. Mr.L.Chandrakumar, learned counsel appearing for petitioner would submit that the petitioner being B.E. Graduate and MBC candidate. He had filed this Writ Petition challenging the notification No.11 of 2024 dated 13.08.2024 relating to Combined Technical Services Examination (Diploma/ITI Level) by direct recruitment for various categories of posts. However, the present Writ Petition related to Sl. No.3(4) of the notification, wherein vacancies relating to Post Code 2119, Motor Vehicle Inspector Grade II, Department of Transport and Road Safety invited applications for 45 vacancies, but so far as distribution of vacancies is concerned, there is no clarification in the notification. On that sole ground, the present Writ Petition has been filed.

3. Mr.B.Vijay, learned counsel appearing for 1<sup>st</sup> respondent would submit that so far as the distribution of vacancies is concerned, subsequently, the respondent had issued an Addendum vide Notification No.11E/2024, dated 21.05.2025 for distribution of 56 vacancies instead of 45 vacancies. Therefore,



the interference of this court with the impugned order passed by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent is not required.

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4. Recording the same, without interfering with the impugned notification, this Writ Petition stands disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to participate in the recruitment process. The interim order already granted by this court dated 26.11.2024 shall stand vacated. No costs. Consequently, connected petition in W.M.P.No. 37392 of 2024 is closed.
