ORDER

This Suo Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Suo Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case, Cr.No.243 of 2023 dated 20.11.2023 is registered for alleged offences under Section 294(b) and 323 of Indian Penal Code, 1860. The defacto complainant has passed away and the wife of defacto complainant has no objection to the case being disposed of. The Accused is attending the proceedings regularly. Due to the unique manner in which this dedicated bench conducts hybrid hearings, the filing of written affidavits or terms of compromise is dispensed with. Considering the factual matrix, the context in which the conflict arose, the background of the parties, and their present position, this is an appropriate case for the exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as per *Gian Singh -Vs State of Punjab & another, (2012 10 SCC 303)*.
