ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.The case was registered in Cr.No.86 of 2019 for the alleged offence under Section 379 of the I.P.C. The allegation in this case is that the accused committed theft of Rs.50 from the defacto complainant. It is reported that the stolen property has been recovered and handed over to the defacto complainant. The defacto-complainant does not want to pursue the case any further. There is no previous or subsequent case against the accused. The accused has been attending the court since 2019.

3.Considering the nature of the allegation, the antecedents of the accused and since the accused has been facing the case since 2019, any further continuation of the trial would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial of the accused and no useful purpose would be served.

4.Accordingly, the case in S.T.C.No.138 of 2025 Judicial Magistrate Court No.II, Jayamkondam Taluk, Ariyalur, stands quashed. This Sua Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
