**ORDER**

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case is registered for alleged offences under Section 279 and 304(A) of Indian Penal Code, 1860. The incident occurred on 13.01.2022. The brother of the defacto complainant is present and submitted that so far no claim petition has been filed. It is still open for him to claim compensation. Police is directed to give them a set of papers and if he want, he can proceed with claiming compensation. He may also approach the Legal Services



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Authority, where the legal aid services shall be provided to him. The

quashing of this case will not in any manner affect such claim petition if any.

3. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the warrant could not be served/executed, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the case in CC.No.938/2022 on the file of the III Metropolitan Magistrate Court, George Town Taluk, Chennai shall stand quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stands disposed of.
