This case in STC.No.1690 of 2024 was taken on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.II, Krishnagiri Taluk, Krishnagiri for the alleged offence(s) under Section 281 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023. The parties have moved on and have no objection to the case being disposed of on compromise. Due to the unique manner in which this dedicated bench conducts hybrid hearings, the filing of written affidavits or terms of compromise is dispensed with. Considering the factual matrix, the context in which the conflict arose, the background of the parties, and their present
