ORDER

This Sua Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Sua Motu W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2.This case in C.C.No.276 of 2017 was taken on the file of the Judicial Magistrate Court, Vandavasi, Vandavasi Taluk, Tiruvannamalai for the alleged offence under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) of I.P.C and Section 4 of TN Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002. It is stated that the de-facto complainant has since died, and the de-facto complainant's husband does not want to proceed with the case further. The parties have moved on and have no objection to the case being disposed of on compromise.

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Due to the unique manner in which this dedicated bench conducts hybrid hearings, the filing of written affidavits or terms of compromise is dispensed with.

3.Considering the factual matrix, the context in which the conflict arose, the background of the parties, and their present position, this is an appropriate case for the exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as per *Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another (2012 10 SCC 303)*.

4.Accordingly, the case in C.C.No.276 of 2017 of Judicial Magistrate Court, Vandavasi, Vandavasi Taluk, Tiruvannamalai, stands quashed. This Suo Motu Transfer Case is disposed of.
