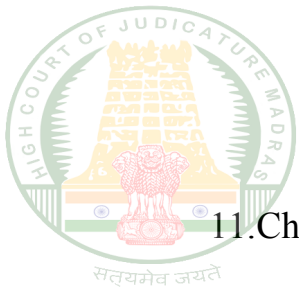

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Salem District in O.S.No.533 of 2004, dated 01.08.2005, based on the petitioner's representation dated 06.06.2024.

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2.The police protection cannot be granted for any property. That apart, the petitioner had already obtained a decree. If at all any violation, the petitioner can easily approach the Civil Court for appropriate relief. Therefore, police protection as sought for by the petitioner in this writ petition cannot be granted by this Court.
