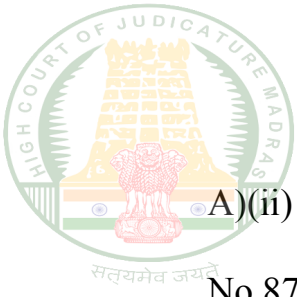

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2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was found in illegal possession 30 litres of ID arrack. Hence, the case.
