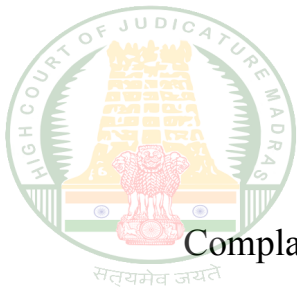

ORDER

This Suo Motu Case is dealt with in an extraordinary manner by the Dedicated Bench, pursuant to Suo Motu.W.P.(Crl.) No.618 of 2025.

2. This case is registered in Cr.No.65 of 2016 for alleged offences under Section 279 and 304(A) of Indian Penal Code, 1860. It is reported that in this case, the defacto Complainant have not filed any claim petition. Therefore, the police are directed to serve a set of papers to him. The defacto

Complainant is at liberty to file a claim petition, if he so desire and he may also approach the Legal Aid Authority where the legal aid services shall be provided to him.

3. Considering the factual matrix, context of the case, the antecedents of the accused, the reason for absence from his usual place, and the submission that, despite best efforts, the summons/warrants could not be served, it is evident that even if the accused is brought to face trial, it would impinge upon his right to a speedy trial. Due to the passage of time, a meaningful trial is unlikely, and no useful purpose would be served.

4. Accordingly, the case in CC.No.111/2020 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate Court, Sendamangalam Taluk, Namakkal shall stand quashed and this Sua Motu Transfer Case stand disposed of.
